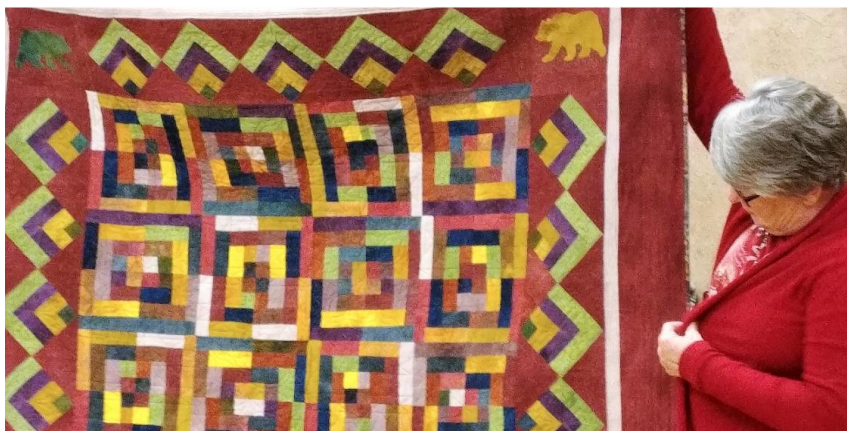

TEQG is a charity group. We select charities each year and donate quilts to these charities. This year our charities are:

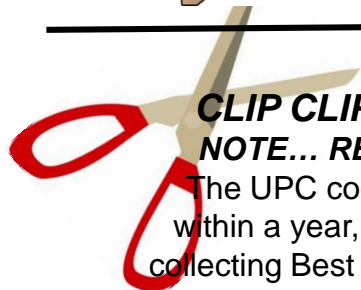
Meals on Wheels – donation of microwave bowls

Quilting Hacks

For a quicker way to sew half square triangles. All you need to do is sew the right sides of your two fabric together in a square. Sew completely around the border. Then cut the square diagonally in both directions. And you're done!

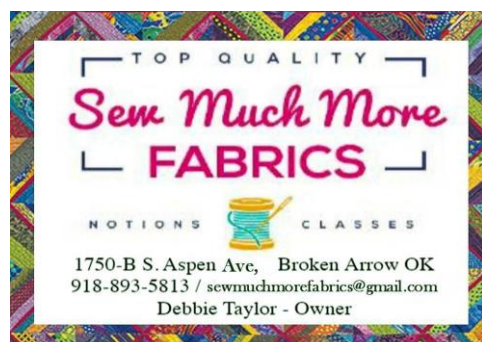
